We are halfway through a great school year at St. Joseph's Catholic School. Educating our children is a whole community effort and the traditions and legacies we value at St. Joseph's will be with us for many years to come. We look forward to continuing to serve our St. Joseph's students, families and community.

At. St. Joseph's Catholic School, we are guided by our mission:

St. Joseph's Catholic School seeks to provide all children with an opportunity to develop spiritually, academically, morally, emotionally, and physically, in an environment of Christ-centered attitudes and values. Staff and parents are committed to preparing students to take their place in their own community and the world at-large by fostering a love for lifelong learning and a responsibility to

We have seen amazing growth in our school this past year - our student population has increased, we built a new playground in a summer, and we installed new first floor flooring. Not only have we seen tangible growth but, more importantly, our students continue to grow spiritually and academically.

We survived a difficult year last year as COVID-19 spread across our globe. With grace and hard work, our students continued to learn and grow. We are grateful and thank God for this! The challenge with COVID-19 is not yet behind us but we will continue to hold true to our mission.

At St. Joseph's, we are not only preparing students to be successful in our K-8 environment but also in their lives beyond our walls. Student growth is an important focus and making sure we have confident learners. Our St. Joseph's teachers and staff are instrumental in the success of our students. They work tirelessly to ensure that our students continue to grow in faith and academic excellence.

This is our self study year as we work toward renewing our school accreditation. We are using a new model to guide our process: The National Standards and Benchmarks for Effective Catholic Elementary and Secondary Schools. There are four focus areas within the framework:

- Mission and Catholic Identity
- Governance and Leadership
- Academic Excellence
- Operational Vitality

We will be seeking our stakeholders' input as we strive for continuous improvement in these areas.

Even with all this growth and change, St. Joseph's Catholic School remains true to our tradition of excellence, educating area students for over 121 years. In 2021, we have:

- 398 students currently enrolled in two classes per grade level
- Waiting lists in multiple grades
- 41 teachers and staff

For the 2021-2022 school year, St. Joseph's Catholic School found itself in a challenging, but positive situation: the school is at capacity. Our school capacity at St. Joseph's Catholic School is 410 students - we determined that keeping the number at 410 would best serve our students. If we were to place the maximum number of students in each class, our school would have around 452 students. However, this would make seating at concerts, access to the restrooms, parent-teacher conferences, playground capacity, etc. a challenge. St. Joseph's Catholic School wants to maintain a high quality of education for all students.

We want to continue to build our Catholic Identity, our academic excellence and our service to our community. Thank you for entrusting us with your child's education. Thank you for your support of St. Joseph's Catholic School!



St. Joseph's Advisory Board



Summary of Expenses and Revenue



The St. Joseph's Parent's Association



St. Joseph's Catholic School History

1900: St. Joseph's School was founded by the Sisters comfort, and to improve of the Holy Cross.

1925: St. Joseph's distinct red brick school building at and library were the corner of 9th and Fort new building had eight classrooms and cost \$38,0000.

1948: The current gymnasium was built at a cost of \$89,000. The new building seated 400 people on permanent bleachers.

1953: St. Joseph's transitioned from an all-boys school to a grammar school for both boys and girls. St. Teresa's Academy transitioned from an all-girls school to a high school for both boys and girls.

1991: Began a multi-phase, 20 year expansion and renovation, with the addition of the Media Center, office and additional classroom space technology upgrades to to the school building.

1997: A new heating and air conditioning system and energy efficient windows were installed to increase efficiency and the learning environment.

1999: The school office remolded. The changes to Street was completed. The the office increased school security and productivity.

> **2002:** Expanded the Media Center and provided five new classrooms, including a Science Lab and Art Room.

2011: E.L. Wiegand Wing completed, adding five new classrooms and finalizing the multi-phase, 20 year expansion and renovation project.

2013: Received a \$50,000 grant from the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Foundation, to become part of the nations first statewide pilot of the Khan Academy- a free, internationally recognized online leader. The grant was used for training and the school.

2014: Received an additional \$70,000 grant from the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Foundation to

provide over 100 Google Chromebooks for the 3rd and 4th grade classrooms.

2015: Revamped the website-www.stjoes.com. The mobile friendly design improves functionality, while continuing to provide information to current and prospective students and families.

2016: Earned a 6 year accreditation status from the Western Catholic Education Association. Added office for full-time counselor and remodeled office space for reading specialists.

2017: Updated school security-additional security cameras, a keypad at the front door, and a new external door to 8th St. were all installed.

2018: Hired student support staff. Installed new carpeting throughout the building. Replaced cement stairs at 9th and Fort Street exits. Continue to revise and implement campus safety plan. Began cycling hardware through five-year Technology

Replacement Plan.

2019: Installed safety window coverings on 8th and Fort Street doors and "stained glass" adhesives to upstairs skylights, bringing Cathedral art into the school.
