St. Joe's Receives \$50,000 Grant! KA IDAHO

St. Joe's is thrilled to be one of 47 schools and more than 10,000 K-12 students across Idaho who will become part of the nation's first statewide pilot of the Khan Academy – the free, internationally recognized online education leader. As a *Rebooting Idaho Schools using Khan Academy* grantee, St. Joe's will receive more than \$50,000 for training, technology, technical assistance and assessment – part of a \$1.5 million allotment from the J.A. and Kathryn Albertson Foundation

"Our teachers love teaching math," says Julianne Russell, middle school teacher. "We are so excited to have this resource available to supplement our regular classroom instruction. Our vision is to send our students into the 'world beyond St. Joe's' with an ownership of their own learning and the resources to address issues when they arise. We are so appreciative to the Albertson's Foundation for this wonderful opportunity."

COMMUNITY SERVICE: PRACTICING RESPONSIBILITY TO OUR COMMUNITY

- Students raised \$3,720 for the San Marcos School computer lab in Cali, Colombia.
- As part of Catholic Schools Week, St. Joe's students raised \$2,800 for the Women and Children's Alliance and donated several boxes of diapers, baby wipes, blankets and clothing.
- Mrs. Weaver and Mrs. Joy's 5th graders worked at the Idaho Food Bank and held a food drive, donating 228 pounds of food the equivalent of 190 meals!
- St. Joe's Middle Schoolers worked at Create Common Ground, a nonprofit work and job training organization for refugees. Students prepared the farm for its Harvest Festival by cleaning out beds and turning the compost pile.
- Mrs. Cox's 1st grade made care packages for troops in Afghanistan.
- Students and families went Christmas Caroling at Interfaith Sanctuary and served the homeless at St. John's Friendship Feast, donating toiletries and gently used winter clothing.
- Kindergarteners made Valentines for children at St. Luke's Hospital and residents at Veterans Medical Center.
- Mrs. Baccay's 4th grade helped with a variety of projects at Ronald McDonald House, including yard clean up, sanitizing playroom toys and labeling pop tab recycling houses.
- Ms. Walters' 4th grade donated handmade blankets and toured the Idaho Humane Society.
